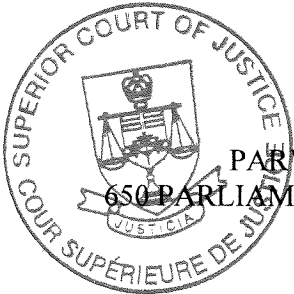

THIS MOTION made by the plaintiffs (i) for an interim order directing the defendants (except Electrical Safety Authority) to cease providing releases to the putative class members and (ii) for an order directing the defendants (except Electrical Safety Authority) to produce to the plaintiffs all forms of releases that have been provided to putative class members for signature and which have been executed by putative class members, together with contact information for such putative class members, was heard this day by the Honourable Justice Belobaba, by tele-conference.

ON BEING ADVISED of the consent of the Responding Parties and their undertaking to immediately cease seeking releases from the putative class members and to treat the executed releases as though they have no force and effect pending the hearing of this motion;

AND ON READING the Moving Parties' Motion Record;

AND ON HEARING the submissions of counsel for the Moving Parties and counsel for the Responding Parties and on being advised that counsel for the defendant Electrical Safety Authority takes no position,


THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. The time for service of the Moving Parties' Motion Record be and is hereby abridged and the Motion Record is properly returnable before this Court.
2. The defendants (except Electrical Safety Authority) shall cease providing releases to the putative class members and shall not ask the putative class members to sign releases in exchange for financial assistance or termination of their tenancies pending the hearing of this motion.
3. The defendants (except Electrical Safety Authority) may continue to have the putative class members execute receipts to confirm any funds received from the defendants.
4. This motion is adjourned to a date to be set by the Court.
